# Town planning officer, aide held for accepting Rs 15 lakh in bribe

THE GUJARAT Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) detained the town planning officer of Gandhinagar and his accomplice for allegedly accepting a bribe of Rs 15 lakh Friday.

According to ACB officials, Town Planning Officer (Grade 1) Nayan Natwarlal Mehta and Planning Assistant (Grade 3) Sanjay Hathila — both associated with the Town Planning Department of the Gandhinagar Urban Development Authority (GUDA) — were held allegedly accepting a bribe of Rs 15 lakh in cash at Mehta's office.

"The complainant's wife was allotted possession of two plots

near the highway in Shertha village of Gandhinagar by the district collector. The complainant had submitted an application with GUDA for the final measurement of the two plots. The power to do measurement was with the accused Mehta who had demanded a bribe of Rs 15 lakh from the complainant," said an ACB official.

The complainant submitted the phone recording of Mehta demanding the bribe after which ACB set a trap. Meanwhile, Mehta had asked the complainant to give Rs 1 lakh to Sanjay Hathila, the second accused, and the remaining amount was supposed to be given to him at his office on Friday.

Both the accused have been detained and booked under sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

# Sanghavi warns of action against cops who misbehave with people

GUJARAT HOME Minister Harsh Sanghavi on Friday warned of taking strict action against police officers who misbehave with people who come file complaints or for passport verification.

Sanghavi was speaking after inaugurating the career guidance centre for children of police personnel and police shopping plaza at Athwalines area in Surat.

Addressing a gathering of police personnel, the minister said, "If a citizen contacts police for registering theft of a mobile phone or for passport verification, he or she should not be called for the second time and also not be kept waiting for long hours in the police station. The police officials should make arrangements in such a way that the citizens get their work done in one go... As we felicitate police officials for their exemplary work, we will also not tolerate any ruthless or misbehavior by police on citizens. If such a complaint comes to us, I will take strict action against them..."

Later, Sanghavi told The Indian Express, "We know that police officials are doing excellent jobs from their ends, but there are a few cops who misbehave towards complainants, which damages

the image of police. Around 60 per cent of complainants come to the police station over mobile theft, vehicle theft or for passport verifications. If they are tackled gently then such issues would not happen. We are moving ahead to make police citizen-friendly. We have told the top police officials to visit the police stations without intimidation, so that they can know the ground-level reality..."

Sanghavi, who was accompanied by representatives of diamond, textile industries, and Southern Gujarat Chamber of Commerce and Industry, also interacted with the students of police personnel who were preparing for competitive exams, for whom the career guidance centre has been started.

# 3 sentenced to 10 years of RI for attempting to rape woman

Ahmedabad: A Rajkot court on April 1 sentenced three accused to 10 years of rigorous imprisonment for attempting to gang-rape a woman in May 2020.

According to prosecution, the case dates back to May 2020, when the accused — Ravi Chauhan, Sagar Zala and Chirag Ravrani — tried to rape the woman who had gone to fetch water from a village tap. The prosecution through Additional Public Prosecutor Kartikey Parekh argued Ravi and Chirag had admitted that they tried to rape the woman while Sagar was recording the video of the act on a mobile phone. The woman had also deposed she was subjected to the sexual acts without her consent.

Dhoraji additional sessions judge Rahul Mahesh Chander Sharma in his verdict noted that "during the recording of her (victim's) testimony, the victim was visibly uncomfortable and she had started crying after seeing the accused persons," and following examination of witnesses and evidence on record, held that the act was committed without consent and against the victim's will.
