In line with Adani Group's target to meet India's Climate Change (NDC) commitments of emission reduction, the company has taken various initiatives such as:

- Increased green cover across AEL businesses by planting 2.9 million trees till FY 2025-26 to increase carbon sink
- Adani solar added 5.2 MW wind capacity and 1.6 MW rooftop solar in addition to existing renewable energy installations.
- Mining process optimization by powder factor improvement that reduces SME consumption
- Implementation of Fuel Management System at Suliari and GP III Coal Mines ensuring accurate monitoring and transparent control of fuel usage, leading to improved operational efficiency, enhanced accountability, and greater reliability through data-driven insights
